

The full list of items required for a **successful sewing bee!**

Sewing

- » Plain sewers
- » Safety stitch (Overlocker) at least one
- » Plenty of filled bobbins
- » Spare needles for all machines
- » Sewing cones for plain sewers (#75 cotton)
- » Sewing cones for safety stitch (#120 cotton)
- » Pin cushions
- » Extension cards
- » Powerboards
- » Snips (with material necklace to wear around neck when sewing)

Note: Consider if any machines and cords need to be tested and tagged

Cutting

- » Material
- » Scissors
- » Tailor's chalk
- » Roller
- » Mat
- » Square ruler
- » Electric fabric cutter
- » Tape measure
- » Bag, handle and pocket templates

Material

- » In various stages (see 'How to run a sewing bee')

Pinning & Marking

- » Pearlhead pins
- » Pin cushions
- » Unpickers (We recommend snips for unpicking)
- » Cardboard templates for pocket placement and corners
- » Marker pens or chalk



Ironing

- » Ironing boards
- » Irons
- » Extension cords

Extras

- » Tape
- » Empty ottoman (pouf) for scrap material
- » Sign on sheet
- » Pens
- » Food and drinks
- » Signage
- » 'Bag it' documentary USB's to borrow and return
- » First Aid Kit
